Rib constructed basket with an antler handle and a pleasing oval shape. The antler sits high so you will have a basket that will be very open. Made using natural and earth tone dyed reed with seagrass accents and antler button and feather focal piece. Aprox. 15x15"

This basket is so much fun! It has a filled bottom and measures 15" high with the handle. It is 12" long by 10" wide and would make a great decorating statement in your home. There are 16 wheels on this basket. It is easier to make them on a dry basket so you will NOT finish the wheels in class but we will start them. They are fun and easy to make. You can rim your basket in class but the wheels are just easier to finish in front of your TV on a dry basket.
