All weaving levels.

RANDOM WEAVE BASKET

A small randomly woven basket with or without a wooden base.

\$5 with no base and \$10 with wooden base.

All weaving levels. Maximum 10, minimum 3 students.

SPALTED BIRCH BOWL

Della Pleski and Sarah Nord

This is a simple bowl style basket that looks dramatic because of the unusual base, decorative rim, and wooden bead accents. The base is a slice of a birch tree that looks like lines have been painted on it because of the spalting.

A functional/decorative basket that is woven with a wooden base in chase weave and finished with a pie crust rim. The base is about 5" with a rim of 9" and the finished basket measuring 5x9x4.

Appropriate for all skill levels. Skills used in this basket are; twining with RR and sea grass, chase weave, shaping, lashing and adding accents. It will take about 3-4 hours. The wooden bead accents are added while you weave.

\$40, extra bases available. Minimum 4, maximum 12.

The bases will be sealed, and spokes set to save time. There will be a choice of plain or variegated reed and wooden beads.

Registration deadline is one week prior.
