BEADED BREAD BOWL

Liz Scheidt, Instructor

The base of this basket is an oval created by lashing the spokes together then creating a spiral in one of the two colors which will be offered. Once the base is completed, new spokes will be inserted before weaving the sides. The rim of the basket is accented by the color chosen for the base with beads inserted to give the short sides handles. The basket is finished with a four-step woven rim.

Dimensions: 13" x 9" x 5 ½"

Weaving level: Advanced Beginner

Cost: \$35 for class and materials

CRACKER BASKET

An ideal basket for serving crackers, breadsticks, or candy. You will most likely find many other uses.

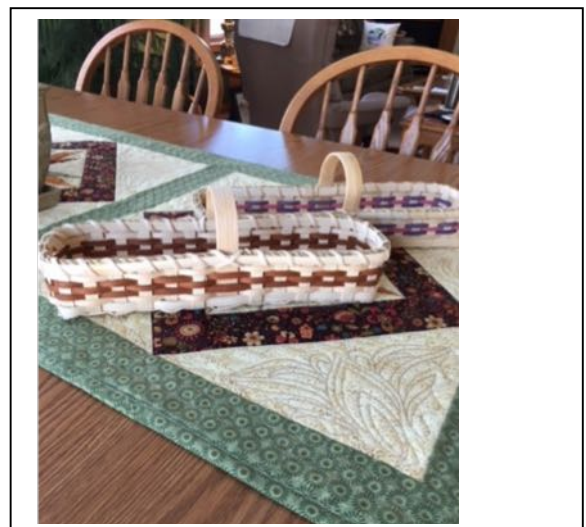
Dimensions: 11" long, 2 ¾" wide, and 2" high, excluding the 3" w x 4" high wood handle

A fairly quick basket to make with wooden slotted base and pretty 12" swing handle. Size: 7" h x 12" diameter at the rim. Even though it is called a Homemaker's Basket, you don't have to be a homemaker to find many uses for it.

NEWSPAPER TUBE BASKET

A small 5" w x 2-4" h, round basket woven with rolled newspaper tubes. You will learn how to make the tubes and work with them. There will be ready-made tubes to work with.
